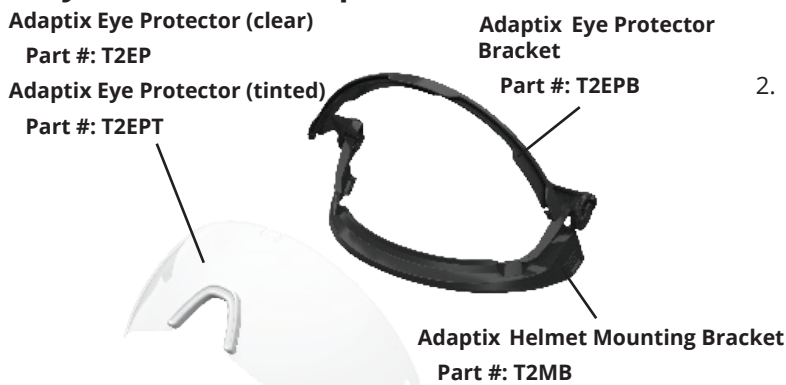
## Eye and Face Protection User Instructions

### GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS AND WARNINGS:

**READ, UNDERSTAND AND FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS AND WARNINGS BEFORE INSTALLING AND USING THE EYE PROTECTOR AND FACE PROTECTOR. IMPROPER USE CAN ADVERSELY IMPACT THE STATED PROTECTION OF THESE PRODUCTS AND RESULT IN DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY.**

- These products should not be installed or used with the FlexBrim attached to the Adaptix Safety helmet.
- These products do NOT provide primary eye protection. No eye protector or face protector, including these products, can protect the user from all possible impacts.
- These products are not shatterproof and will not protect eyes from harmful rays.
- Large objects and/or objects traveling at high speeds may break or penetrate these products and injure the user's eyes or face. Additional protection may be required.
- Inspect these products before each use. If damaged, the product must be immediately replaced. Do NOT use damaged eye or face protectors .
- Use of substances other than mild detergent and water to clean these products can cause damage and render them unsafe for use. The damage may not be apparent or readily detectable by the user.
- Do not store the eye or face protectors in an environment that exceeds 120°F (49°C). Do not store in direct sunlight.

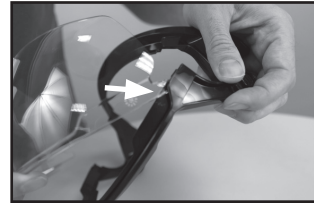

### Eye Protector assembly and replacement

#### Installing the eye protector to its bracket:

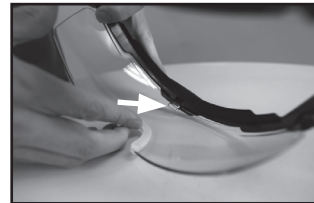
1. Insert the left and right tabs of the eye protector into the slots of the eye protector bracket. (See Figure 1)

2. Rotate the eye protector up until its center hook snaps into the eye protector bracket. (See Figure 2)

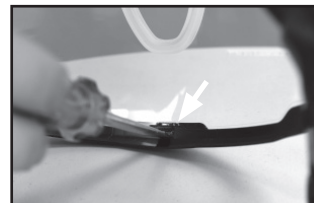


#### Removing the eye protector from its bracket

The eye protector should only be removed when replacing it.

1. Insert the tip of a flathead screwdriver at the location highlighted. (See Figure 3)

2. Twist the screwdriver to pop the hook out of the slot on the bracket. (See Figure 4)

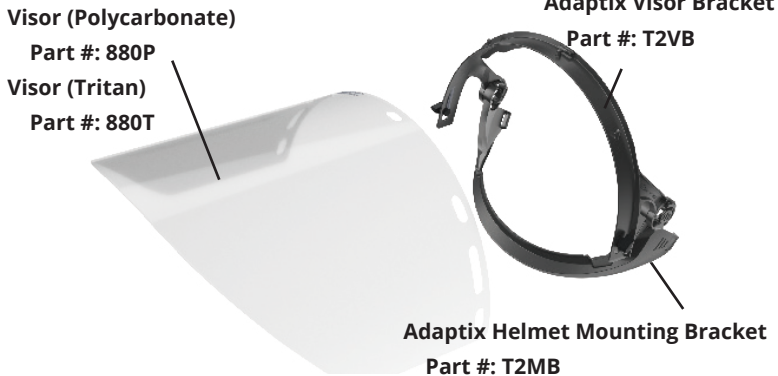

## Visor assembly and replacement

### Installing the visor to its bracket:

1. Tuck the center of the top edge of the visor under the center tab of the bracket and rotate until the post protrudes through the opening in the visor. (See Figure 5)

2. On both the left and right sides, rotate the retention knob's pointed end to face the front, and push it through the slot on the visor. (See Figure 6)

3. Rotate the retention knobs' pointed ends to face the rear. (See Figure 7)

### Removing the visor from its bracket

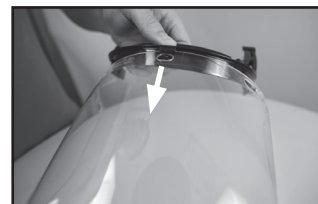
1. On both the left and right sides, rotate the retention knob's pointed end to face the front and detach the corner of the visor. (See Figure 8)

2. Rotate the center of the visor up until it pops out of the center tab of the bracket. (See Figure 9)

## Instructions for use

### Attaching and Removing the Adaptix Eye or Face Protector:

The Bullard Adaptix Eye and Face Protectors are only compatible with the Bullard Adaptix Helmet. They cannot be used while a FlexBrim is attached to the helmet.

1. Align the product to the front of the helmet. The lower lip of the helmet mounting bracket slips under the front of the helmet. (See Figure 10)

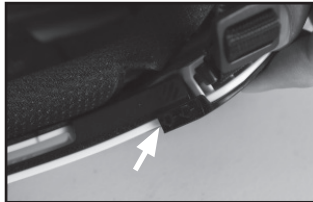
2. Press the bottom corners of the helmet mounting bracket on both the left and right sides until they snap onto the helmet. (See Figure 11)

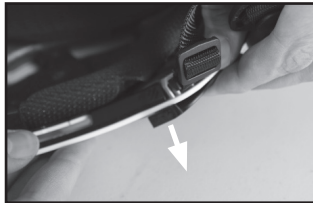
3. Check that the hooks on both sides have wrapped around the edge of the helmet. (See Figure 12)

4. To remove the product from the helmet, apply pressure to either bottom corner of the helmet mounting bracket and pry the hook off the helmet. (See Figure 13)

### Using the Adaptix Eye or Face Protector

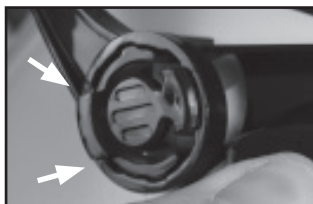
The eye protector or visor can be rotated to upper stowed positions. It must be rotated all the way to the lowest position to provide protection.

### Removing and attaching the eye protector or visor bracket from the helmet mounting bracket

The brackets can be separated for replacement or to swap with other compatible Bullard brackets. These steps may optionally be performed while the helmet mounting bracket is installed on the helmet.

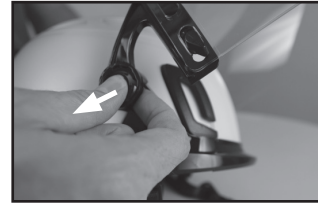
1. Rotate the eye protector or visor bracket until the arrows on both brackets are aligned. (See Figure 14)

2. On both the left and right sides, place a thumb on the round button of the helmet mounting bracket and pry the ring of the eye protector or visor bracket away from the button. (See Figure 15)

3. To attach an eye protector or visor bracket, on both the left and right sides, align the arrows and tuck the ring of the eye protector or visor bracket behind the hook of the helmet mounting bracket. Then press the rest of the ring down until it snaps. (See Figure 16)

### Cleaning

Clean the eye or face protector with mild soap and lukewarm water. Do NOT use paint, solvents, chemicals, adhesives, gasoline, or like substances on the products. The impact resistance and other protective properties of the products may be diminished by such substances. Damage caused by these substances may not be apparent or readily detectable by the user.

### Service life

The eye or face protectors do not have an indefinite service life. Conditions found in many work environments such as exposure to ultraviolet light, temperature extremes, chemical exposure, and wear and tear from daily use will reduce the protective properties of the products over time.

It is noted that you must inspect your products regularly for cracks or any damage before each use. If any damage appears, this will compromise the stated protection of the products.

### Storage

Store the eye or face protectors in a clean, dry environment, not over 120°F (49°C). Do NOT store in direct sunlight. Do NOT store the products in areas such as the dashboard of an automobile or truck bed of a work vehicle.
